



## Mountain Shadows Club 100 7th Annual Marathon Golf Tournament, June 7, 2010

Oaks North Golf Course in  
Rancho Bernardo

Each year Mountain Shadows Foundation holds a marathon golf tournament at the Oaks North Golf Club in Rancho Bernardo, San Diego County. Oaks North is the number one rated executive golf course in California and consists of 27 distinct holes (3 nines). Mountain Shadows rents the entire golf course for the whole day. We invite between 22 and 42 (max) golfers to play 100 holes of golf in one day. The beauty of this for the golfer is that they are treated like royalty. The day before the tournament, they are the guests of our hospitality at the Rancho Bernardo Inn for dinner and for an overnight stay in one of their luxuriously appointed deluxe rooms. The inn is less than five minutes from the golf course (Oaks North) where the tournament is held.

The golfers tee off at 7:00 a.m. and are treated to a farm-style breakfast, a real BBQ lunch, and a gourmet dinner on the course. Also included this year, as in every year, will be a variety of games, contests, and challenges that offer the golfer the opportunity to win valuable prizes.



This year, one of the contests that our golfers are looking forward to is a fly-casting contest right in the middle of the tournament, including lessons from an expert fly fisherman.

All of this is free to the golfer! There is one requirement—each golfer that earns a spot in this tournament must have sponsorship levels of \$50/hole. Most of our golfers get sponsors to donate \$.25, \$.50, or \$1.00 per hole and they have no trouble meeting the qualifying requirement.

Our top earner in the past played for \$256/hole, raised \$25,600 in one day and, to quote him, “. . . had the most fun playing the most fun golf he has ever had.”

This gentleman was Mr. Joe Rich of Rich Development and he was featured in a feature article in *Escondido Magazine*, Spring 2007. He was participating in our Win/Win program in which the golfer splits 50/50 all of his earned donations with Mountain Shadows. Mr. Rich raised over \$12,000 for the developmentally disabled residents of Mountain Shadows and over \$12,000 for his children's Holy Trinity Catholic School.

This year, the Win/Win is even better. Once the golfer has earned \$5,000 for Mountain Shadows, then all ***proceeds are split on a 90/10 basis, with 90% of the proceeds going to the golfer's alternative charity!***

## **TOURNAMENT DESCRIPTION AND PREREQUISITES**

- Play will begin at 7:00 a.m. and conclude upon completion of 100 holes.
- There will be a minimum of 22 and a maximum of 42 golfers selected to participate in this event.
- All golfers will play at their own pace; however, they must allow faster players to play through.
- The maximum number of strokes per hole will be double par (6 or 8).
- There will be witnesses at the cash prize hole-in-one tees, but the rest of the prize holes will be on the honor system.
- Golfers will be selected to participate based upon the following criteria:
  - All golfers must secure a minimum of \$50/hole in sponsors;
  - All golfers must commit to completing 4 rounds of 27 holes (or best serious effort);
  - All golfers must agree to turn in a completed score card.
